



## The Jo Wattleworth Scholarship

*Print-out application form*

The Jo Wattleworth Scholarship is available to **undergraduate students** undertaking a university course who are current student members of the College. **The value of the scholarship is \$2,000.** The scholarship is to be used to support the student in their studies.

The applicant must produce an essay, learning contract or portfolio of work in which the significance of the psychosocial or humanistic aspects of nursing are featured. This scholarship is offered by Jo Melville, a Fellow of The College of Nursing.

### Eligibility Criteria Checklist

- The **applicant** must be a current undergraduate nursing student.
- The **applicant** must be a current student member of the College.
- If **an essay**, the content must emphasize the central importance of the psychosocial aspects of nursing to the wellbeing or care of an individual. The essay must be a minimum 1000 words and be reflective of current literature.
- If a **learning contract** or **portfolio**, the documents must be accompanied by a summary that makes explicit the ways in which the student has emphasized the psychosocial or humanistic aspects of nursing.

### Documents Required Checklist

- 1. Fully completed application form including correct cover sheet and signed statement of agreement to terms and conditions of award (Section 3).
- 2. Your essay or;
- 3. Learning contract or portfolio with attached summary.

### Selection

The Scholarships Committee of the College of Nursing will undertake assessment of applications within one (1) month of the closing date. The Committee's decision will be final. Applications are competitive and the College reserves the right to withdraw the award should conditions not be satisfied, or to award less than the full amount in any year. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. The successful applicant(s) will be notified in writing, and will be presented with the Scholarship formally at The College Annual Oration and Investiture.
